



**Public Notice: The United States Army Will Hold a Public Meeting on the Proposed Plan for Remedial Action at Operable Unit 9 Iowa Army Ammunition Plant Middletown, Iowa**

The United States (U.S.) Army in conjunction with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) is initiating a Remedial Action (RA) for two Construction Debris Sites within Operable Unit 9 at the Iowa Army Ammunition Plant (IAAAP) located in Middletown, Iowa. These sites include Construction Debris Site 1 and Construction Debris Site 2, both located in the central part of IAAAP. The Army, with oversight by the U.S. EPA and the Iowa Department of Natural Resources, is conducting this RA as defined by the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), the National Contingency Plan (NCP), and IAAAP Federal Facilities Agreement. IAAAP was listed on the National Priorities List in 1990.

No Further Action is recommended for Construction Debris Site 1 since there are no unacceptable risks and no remedial action objectives. At Construction Debris Site 2, the Preferred Remedial Alternative is Removal and Disposal of Asbestos Containing Material (ACM) Debris Piles.

**Public Comment Period – April 10, 2023, to May 10, 2023.**

The Army will hold a 30-day public comment period for the Revised Proposed Plan and the Remedial Action from April 10, 2023, to May 10, 2023. The Army will consider all formal relevant comments prior to making a final decision.
