The United States Army Will Hold a Public Meeting on the Proposed Plan for Remedial Action at Operable Unit 5 lowa Army Ammunition Plant Middletown, lowa

The United States (U.S.) Army in conjunction with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) is initiating a Remedial Action (RA) for two Munitions Response Sites (MRSs) within Operable Unit 5 at the Iowa Army Ammunition Plant (IAAAP) located in Middletown, Iowa. These MRSs include the Possible Demolition Site and the Incendiary Disposal Area. The Army, with oversight by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the Iowa Department of Natural Resources, is conducting this RA as defined by the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), the National Contingency Plan (NCP), and IAAAP Federal Facilities Agreement. IAAAP was listed on the National Priorities List in 1990.

Due to a change in mission, the future use of the two MRSs has changed to allow for development and increased access. As a result, the Preferred Remedial Alternative for each of the MRSs is changing from Land Use Controls to Munitions and Explosives of Concern Subsurface Clearance to achieve Unlimited Use/Unrestricted Exposure.

Public Comment Period - July 17, 2024, to August 21, 2024.

The Army will hold a 30-day public comment period for the Revised Proposed Plan and the Remedial Action from July 17, 2024, to August 21, 2024. The Army will consider all formal relevant comments prior to making a final decision.
