Public Notice: The United States Army Will Hold a Public Meeting on the Proposed Plan for Remedial Action at Operable Unit 4 Iowa Army Ammunition Plant Middletown, Iowa

The United States (U.S.) Army in conjunction with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) is initiating a Remedial Action (RA) for the groundwater at the Inert Disposal Area (IDA) site within Operable Unit 4 at the Iowa Army Ammunition Plant (IAAAP) located in Middletown, Iowa. This site is located in the central part of IAAAP. The Army, with oversight by the U.S. EPA and the Iowa Department of Natural Resources, is conducting this RA as defined by the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), the National Contingency Plan (NCP), and IAAAP Federal Facilities Agreement. IAAAP was listed on the National Priorities List in 1990.

For the groundwater at the IDA, the Preferred Remedial Alternative is Monitored Natural Attenuation (MNA) with Land Use Controls (LUCs).

Public Comment Period – July 15, 2024, to August 14, 2024.

The Army will hold a 30-day public comment period for the Revised Proposed Plan and the Remedial Action from July 15, 2024, to August 14, 2024. The Army will consider all formal relevant comments prior to making a final decision.
